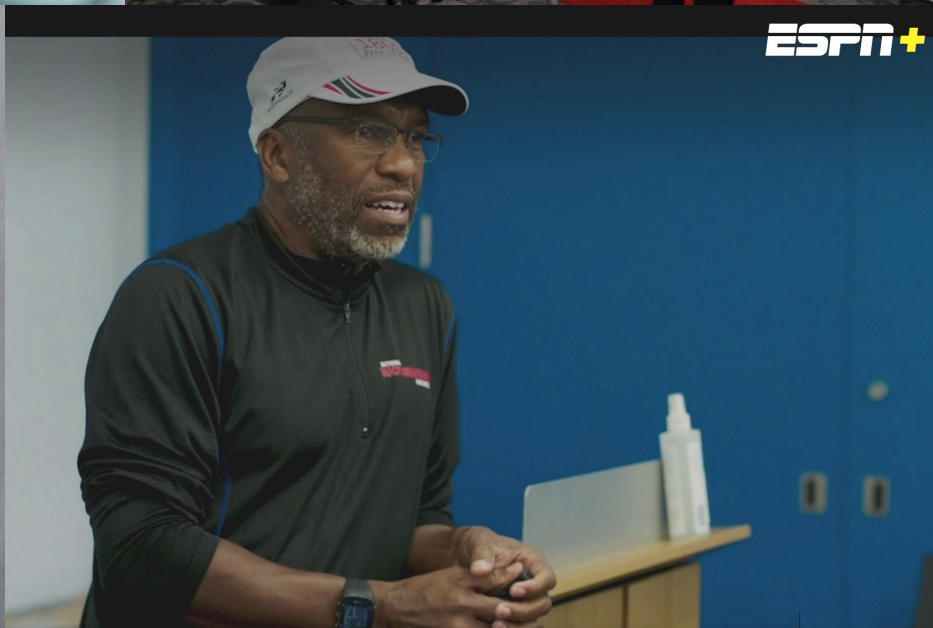

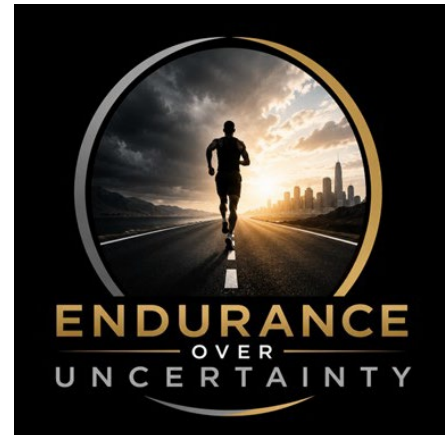

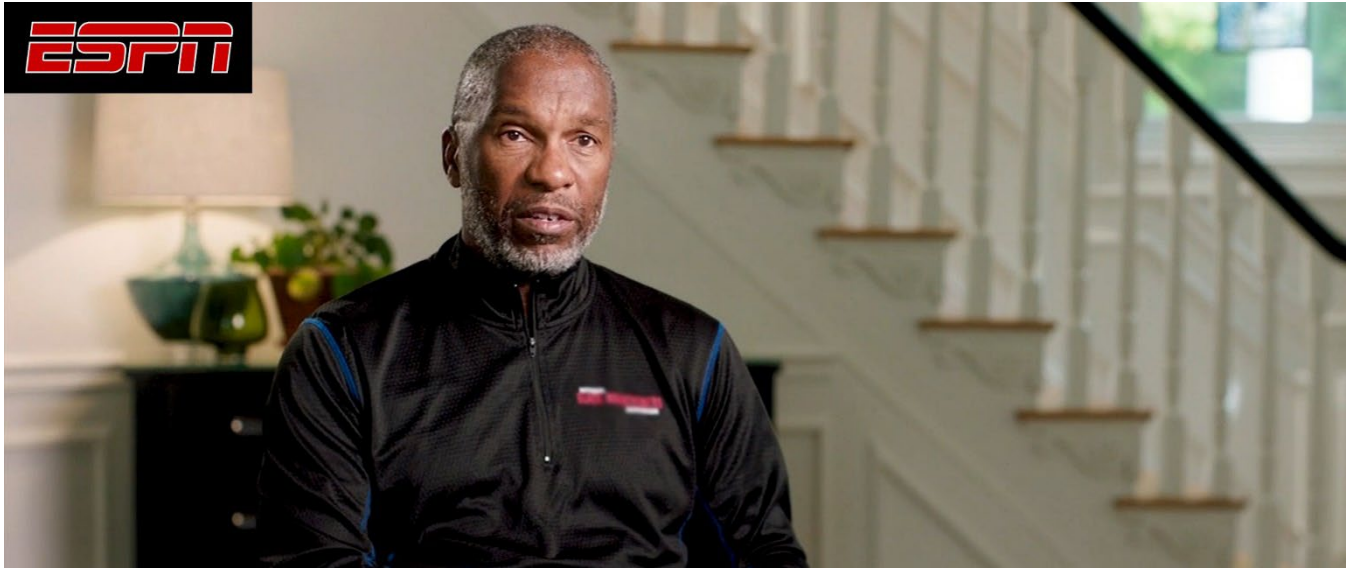

This includes leadership, risk management, change management, motivation, negotiations, content development, storytelling, and coaching. A runner has no control over a challenging marathon course. They can only control their approach to the hills that lie ahead.

4. He Shares Real World Business Experiences

Anthony brings experiences from being employed at Fortune 100 companies, governmental agencies (federal, county, and city), quasigovernment agencies, and consulting firms. He's also the CEO and founder of an international firm. He's managed highly visible and high-stress international projects with internationally dispersed, multi-generational team members.

Anthony relates to everyone. He has finished first and dead last in races. He's dealt with a wide variety of marathon day weather from sub-zero temps in Antarctica to over 100-degree temps in Texas. He's even dealt with bicycle derailleur cables snapping in a biathlon and being chased by seals during a marathon. He knows how to manage stress and take risks to win.

5. He's a History Making Athlete, Certified Running Coach, and a Witness to History

Anthony is the first Black in the world to complete marathons on all seven continents. He's also one of about fifty people in the world who completed the marathon "hat trick." This consists of finishing (1) at least one hundred marathons (2) in all fifty States and (3) seven continents. For these and other accomplishments, he was inducted into a national hall of fame. He also wrote an article about his experiences in the finish line area during the 2013 Boston Marathon bombing.

6. He's an Award-Winning Writer and Storyteller (See pages 10 through 12)

Anthony is an award-winning documentary writer and director. His first film, *Breaking Three Hours*, won fourteen awards, including eight first place finishes, in film festivals in the US, Canada, and Sweden. It was selected by Amazon Prime within eight days after it was available for streaming services. *Runner's World* described it as one of "The best running documentaries that motivate and inspire."

His second documentary, *We ARE Distance Runners*, has been selected by over twenty festivals in the US, Canada, Sweden, France, and India. It received twenty-seven award nominations and earned nineteen awards, including ten first place finishes.



ONE-PAGE BIOGRAPHY

Anthony Reed, CPA, PMP is true polymath. He's a former Fortune 500 technology executive, an international professional speaker, author, forty-time award winning documentary director and writer, two-time history making hall of fame marathoner, and business executive. He spent over twenty-five years in management and executive positions for companies, such as Texas Instruments, Accor, Siemens, Pepsico/Frito-Lay, Ernst & Young, and the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas. He has authored six books and over fifty articles about leadership, technology, and fitness. In addition to having his consulting firm, he's currently the founder and CEO of the Caribbean Endurance Sports Corporation and Free to Run Productions Inc. He served on the board of directors for various professional, technology, and non-profit organizations.

He recently directed, produced, and wrote the feature length documentaries *Breaking Three Hours* and *We ARE Distance Runners*, which have won forty awards at US, Canadian, Swedish, and Indian film festivals. His latest books are *Running to Leadership: What Finishing 100+ Marathons on All Seven Continents Teaches Us About Success* and his autobiography, *From the Road Race to the Rat Race*.

He earned two graduate degrees (management and accounting) and two undergraduate degrees (management and mathematics). He's taught collegiate project management, information technology, accounting, and business management courses. He's a Certified Public Accountant, certified Project Management Professional, and certified Supply Chain Manager.

His accomplishments and exploits have been featured in the business, technical, travel, and sports sections of major newspapers and publications across the country. This includes the *Ebony* (twice), ESPN's *The Undeclared*, *USA Today*, the *Wall Street Journal*, *Runner's World*, *PMI Today*, *Southern Living*, *Run Singapore*, *Sports & Travel*, *Black Sports - The Magazine*, *Texas Runner & Triathlete*, *Black MBA Magazine*, *Dallas Morning News*, the *Ft. Worth Star Telegram*, and the *Journal of Accountancy*. He's also been interviewed on radio, television, and internet programs around the world, including several NPR stations, Black America Web, CBS, NBC, Good Morning Texas, and Arise-TV.

As a Certified Distance Running Coach, he won trophies in biathlons (running and bicycling) and in road races ranging from 5K's to 26.2-mile marathons. He's one of about sixty people in the world, who completed the marathon hat trick. This consists of finishing (1) at least one hundred marathons on (2) all seven continents, including Antarctica, and (3) in all fifty States. He's also completed over fifty marathons in one state, Texas. He was inducted into the National Distance Running Hall of Fame in 2022. He is the first Black in world to run marathons on all seven continents. Subsequently, his running clothes and other artifacts are with Washington DC's Smithsonian Museum of African American History and Culture. A three-hour video of his life story is in the special HistoryMakers section of the US Library of Congress. Subsequently, his journeys were chronicled in his book, *Running Shoes Are Cheaper Than Insulin: Marathon Adventures on All Seven Continents*.

Anthony Reed was having lunch with a former staff member, Chris. Chris confided in Anthony, "I don't understand what's happening. I'm not satisfied with my job anymore. I'm doing the same work, when you were over the division, but it's just not fun or fulfilling. What did you do?"

Anthony explained that he had managed the division and led the employees by using the same techniques that he used to run marathons and to coach other successful runners. People became highly motivated, embraced (calculated) risks, moved outside of their comfort zones, and achieved corporate and personal goals. The employees had become mental marathoners. Strong individuals make strong teams. (You're only as strong as the weakest link.)

Anthony had been successfully employing marathon coaching techniques as a transformative leader in corporate America and in governmental entities. Years later, researchers discovered a direct link between successful managers and marathoners. They are both thrill seekers; Type T personalities. As a 132-time, history-making marathoner and a 25-year business executive, Anthony is comfortable about sharing his real-world, insightful, and entertaining challenges and solutions with your audience. The same soft skills he used to motivate and inspire his staff were used to motivate and inspire over 100,000 distance runners.
